Attached [following] is the HOME ARP Allocation Plan, which was approved by HUD. Originally, the Fund's HOME ARP application was estimated to be released in the 4th quarter 2022. However, the HOME ARP application is scheduled to released in the 1st quarter 2023.

HOME ARP eligible activities are:

- Development of affordable housing pursuant to Title II of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990
- Supportive services to qualifying individuals or families not already receiving such supportive services, including:
 - o Activities listed in section 401(29) of McKinney -Vento Act
 - Housing counseling; and
 - Homeless prevention services
- Acquisition and development of non-congregate shelter units
- Nonprofit Operating Assistance

HOME-ARP Qualifying Populations are:

- Homeless (McKinney definition)
- At-risk of homelessness (McKinney definition)
- Fleeing/attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual violence, stalking, or human trafficking
- Other populations for whom supportive services or assistance would prevent the family's homelessness or serve those with the greatest risk of housing instability
